The Kasc Project [M] is the world's first Hybrid Cask Single Malt Irish whiskey. An extension to their unique and popular Hybrid Cask Whiskey collection and a continuation of their journey into the new and previously unknown ways of whiskey making, using unusual and bespoke casks.

The KASC Project is a bold experiment in whiskey-making using the provenance of wood as the key factor of flavour design and construction. Each whiskey is made in a hand made "hybrid" cask, individually constructed from a mix of 5 different types of trees from unique origins: Portuguese Oak, American Oak, French Oak, Hungarian Oak and Chestnut. The individual habitat of each type of tree brings a completely unique flavour variant to this innovative whiskey, creating a multi-dimensional flavour and character.





Scotland's most northerly mainland distillery, situated near Thurso just a few miles south of John O'Groats. While there was once a distillery by the name Wolfburn in the area, no bottles of its whisky remain. New Wolfburn has started with a blank slate, making an unpeated dram that already has whisky fans talking.

Crafted from a combination of spirit matured for eight years in first-fill ex-bourbon hogsheads, married with spirit matured for seven years in first-fill Caribbean rum barrels. The flavour of the resultant whisky is a triumph, combining the smooth sophistication of bourbon maturation with unique sweetness and depth from the rum casks.





Back in 2000, John Glaser was working for a large UK distillery when he realised that there was so much that hadn't yet been explored in the world of Scotch whisky. An American living in London, he decided to do something refreshingly different and bring the joys of Scotch whisky to more people in exciting new ways.

John started Compass Box, an inventive company based on the long-lost model of the Scotch whisky blending house, but with a forward-looking approach and an unrelenting desire to create deliciousness.

The Story of The Spaniard

Released in batches, with the batch number shown on the back label, The Story of the Spaniard is a tribute to Sherry's broad spectrum of styles. This is the last opportunity to purchase this whisky, as this will be the last batch available in BC. You will find a whisky that is full and soft on the palate with flavours of citrus peel and pears poached in red wine and spices.

Matured in the finest sherry casks, this Forty Year Old single malt delivers fragrant spices and stewed red berries, followed by Morello cherry, dark chocolate and mature oak.

Meikle Toir The Sherry One

+238615 WHLS: \$77.38 6 x 700ml SPEC

Made using mainland peat from St. Fergus, the sweet phenolic content of the whisky amounts to 35 PPM. A lengthy fermentation period of 160 hours results in a fruit-forward spirit that lends itself perfectly to ageing in the finest Sherry oak. Notes of dark chocolate, smoked honey and mocha, with figs, treacle, burnt sugar and puffs of peat smoke on the palate.

A nostalgic journey with aromas of sherried sweetness, reminiscent of childhood candy bars and tropical fruit punch. On the palate, it offers rich and spicy flavours of grilled pineapple, burnt sugars, and charred oak. The finish harmoniously blends fruity, and nutty notes with toasted oak. This whisky exemplifies elegance and complexity, standing as a timeless classic.

LIGHT

This end of the axis houses whiskies characterized by fresh flavours: green grass, soft fruits and cereal. This is often a reflection of the whisky-making process, such as fermentation or the size and shape of the stills.

RICH


The rich end of the axis contains characteristics often derived from the wood used during maturation. Flavours range from vanilla (American oak casks) to nuttiness and dried fruit (European oak casks).

SMOKY

Whiskies found in the two smoky quadrants all contain discernible levels of peat, which is burned in the malting process. Ranging from scented smoke and bonfires, to kippers and black tea.

DELICATE

These whiskies normally use no peat in the malting process. Towards the light end there is a floral. grassy freshness, where as the richer side presents subtler nutty, barley and biscuity flavours.
